

DRAINAGE MEETING  
DRAINAGE DISTRICT GRANT #5  
SEPTEMBER 22, 2020

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in the Public Meeting Room in the Story County Administration Building in Nevada, Iowa to consider the handling of appeals (on file in the Story County Auditor's Office) filed against the August 24, 2020 annexation of additional lands into Drainage District Grant #5. Members present were Linda Murken, chair, Lisa Heddens, and Lauris Olson. Also present were County Assistant Attorney Ethan Anderson, Engineer Darren Moon, Outreach and Special Projects Coordinator Leanne Harter, and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Murken called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. and stated that the meeting was being held virtually on the Zoom videoconferencing platform due the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the attendant risks of meeting in person.

Heddens moved, seconded by Olson, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Heddens moved, seconded by Olson, to close the session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(c). MCU at 9:17 a.m. Harter left the room and returned when the session was reopened.

The open session was reconvened at 9:44 a.m.

Olson moved, seconded by Heddens, to recommend to the Story County Board of Supervisors that they approve a resolution, pursuant to Iowa Code Section 468.88, to retain Robert Goodwin, a local attorney with expertise in drainage district matters, at a rate of \$200.00 per hour to represent Drainage District Grant #5 in the matter of appeals filed by Eric Eide and Cynthia Hildebrand against the annexation of additional lands to said district. MCU.

Heddens moved, seconded by Olson, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:46 a.m.
