

## 11/20/2012 - Minutes

### 1. CALL TO ORDER

- 1.1. The Board Of Supervisors, Acting As The Board Of Canvassers, Will Meet On Tuesday, November 20, 2012, At 9:30 Am In The Public Meeting Room At Story County Administration To Re-Canvass The Soil And Water Conservation District Commissioner Race, Held On November 6, 2012.

The Board of Supervisors met November 20, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. in the Board Room at Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers to correct the results of the Soil and Water District Commissioners elected at General Election, held on November 6, 2012. Wayne E. Clinton, Rick Sanders and Paul Toot present, with Chairperson Wayne E. Clinton presiding.

Lucy Martin, Auditor, reported that following the canvass of votes on Wednesday, November 14, the Auditor's Office was notified by the Soil and Water Conservation District that two of the commissioner candidates on the ballot reside in the same township (Franklin). Although both candidates live in the City of Ames, it is the former underlying township that determines jurisdiction. Therefore write-in votes were used to determine the third commissioner elected on November 6, 2012. Martin read Iowa Code §161.5 (e) into the record.

Clinton read the results of the election.

Sanders moved, Toot seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the election to the proper jurisdictions (on file in the Auditor's office). Roll call vote. (MCU)
