- 1.I. Consider A Levy For Deficiency Against Joint Drainage District Polk-Story #2, Story County Controlling  
DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING  
JOINT DISTRICTS POLK-STORY #2 & #4  
MAY 28, 2013

The Drainage District Trustees of Polk and Story Counties met in the Board Conference Room of the Story County Administration Building in a telephone conference call to consider levies against Joint Drainage Districts Polk -Story #2, Story County controlling, and Polk -Story #4, Polk County controlling. Members present were Tom Hockensmith, chair, Robert Brownell, Angela Connolly, Steve Van Oort, and John Mauro of Polk County and Rick Sanders, chair, and Wayne Clinton of Story County. Also present were Polk County Land Use Planning Manager Bret Vandelune and Drainage Clerk Rebecca Dewey and Story County Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Sanders called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

Wall said Polk -Story #2 is being levied for deficiency due to repairs by Story County Secondary Roads tile crews (see attached sheet for figures).

Brownell and Clinton moved, seconded by Connolly and Sanders, to levy Polk-Story #2 at 12% of its original assessed value, said levy to be dated May 28, 2013 with payments due on or before September 30, 2013. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Vandelune said Polk-Story #4 is also being levied for deficiency (see attached).

Connolly and Clinton moved, seconded by Brownell and Sanders, to levy Polk-Story #4 at 10% of its original assessed value, said levy to be dated May 28, 2013 with payments due on or before September 30, 2013. MCU.

Sanders moved, seconded by Brownell, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 2:07 p.m.
