

**The Board of Supervisors met on November 12, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers for the General Election, held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014. Paul Toot, and Rick Sanders present, with Chairperson Toot presiding. Wayne E. Clinton absent.**

**Lucy Martin, Auditor and Commissioner of Elections, stated the Board had to draw lots for the following races due to tie votes: Grant Township Trustee, Nevada Township Trustee, New Albany Township Clerk, and Union Township Trustee. Toot read the results of the election for each race on the ballot. Martin announced there were 331 provisional ballots cast for this election. Of the 331 provisional ballots, 308 were accepted and 23 rejected.**

**Martin thanked the Board for letting her designate funds for new equipment. The current election equipment is showing its age. On November 4, three machines had to be cleaned in the field and two had to be replaced with spares. Story County processed a record number (15,172) of absentee ballots for a gubernatorial election. Martin thanked her staff, Cal Pearson and his Facilities Management staff, and Kevin Norris, Deputy Auditor. Newly-elected County officials and their appointed deputies will be sworn in on January 2, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in the Administration Building's Public Meeting Room.**

**Sanders moved, Toot seconded to declare the canvass complete and to certify the results of the election to the proper jurisdiction (on file in the Auditor's Office). Roll call vote. (MCU)**
