

The Board of Supervisors met December 1, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board Room at the Story County Administration Building as the Board of Canvassers for the City Election held on November 3, 2015, in order to draw lots in the case of write-in tie votes pursuant to *Code of Iowa* §50.44 and §376.11(2). Paul Toot and Wayne E. Clinton present with Toot presiding. Rick Sanders absent. Lucy Martin, Auditor, reported it was necessary to reconvene as the Board of Canvassers because, for city elections, if a write in winner declines office in writing to the city clerk within ten days of the canvass, the write-in candidate with the next-highest number of votes is declared the winner. In the case of the mayoral race for the City of McCallsburg, the write-in winner submitted a resignation letter and there was a tie for second place between Bill Lytle and Walley Loney. Toot drew Loney's name. Toot read the results, noting the winner of the drawn lots.

Clinton moved, Toot seconded to certify the results of the drawing of lots for the Mayor of the City of McCallsburg. Roll call vote. (MCU)

Martin stated as a write-in winner, Loney is not required to accept the office. If he submits a resignation or does not take the oath of office by the beginning of the term, there will be a vacancy for Mayor of McCallsburg.

Clinton moved, Toot seconded to adjourn at 9:33 a.m. (MCU)
