

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING  
JOINT DISTRICTS HAMILTON-STORY #1 & #5  
APRIL 5, 2016

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building in Nevada, IA to consider levies (see attached) against Joint Drainage Districts Hamilton #105-Story #1, Story County controlling, and Hamilton #149-Story #5, Hamilton County controlling. Both levies had already been approved by the Hamilton County Drainage District Trustees. Members present were Paul Toot, chair, Rick Sanders, and Wayne Clinton. Also present were County Engineer Darren Moon and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Toot called the meeting to order at 9:45 a.m.

Wall said Hamilton #105-Story #1 has been the site of an ongoing project to remove trees and brush from the open drainage ditch. Recent work by Story County Integrated Vegetation Roadside Management (IVRM) personnel has depleted the district fund to a negative \$1,760.89. IVRM does not intend to do any work in the district in 2016 but they do plan to control regrowth of vegetation through spraying in 2017. Wall is recommending a 12% levy against the district which is sufficient to pay expenses and leave about \$5,000 (\$4,779.11) in the district fund.

Sanders moved, seconded by Clinton, to accept Wall's recommendation and levy Hamilton #105-Story #1 at 12% of its original assessed value, said levy to be dated July 1, 2016 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2016. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Wall said Hamilton County hires an outside contractor to control vegetative growth in their open ditches. Hamilton #149-Story #1 will be treated in 2016 and the Hamilton Drainage Clerk is recommending a 169% levy to cover the contractor's bid costs.

Sanders moved, seconded by Clinton, to accept the recommendation of the Hamilton County Drainage Clerk and levy Hamilton #149-Story #5 at 169% of its original assessed value, said levy to be dated July 1, 2016 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2016.

Sanders moved, seconded by Clinton, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
