

**The Board of Supervisors met on September 15, 2017, at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers for the School Election held on Tuesday, September 12, 2017.**

**Rick Sanders, Marty Chitty, and Lauris Olson with Chairperson Sanders presiding.**

**Lucy Martin, Auditor, made comments about the first use of ID scanners and poll worker management software. The absentee ballot return rate was 93%. Colo-NESCO had the highest turnout with 47% of registered voters participating. She spoke briefly about the certification resolution. Sanders and Martin shared the reading of election results. 5,480 people voted at the polls, and the Absentee Board accepted 394 absentee ballots and three provisional ballots.**

**Chitty moved, Olson seconded the approval of Resolution #18-33. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.**

**Chitty moved, Olson seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the school election. Roll call vote. (MCU)**
