

DRAINAGE MEETING
JOINT DISTRICT BOONE #28-STORY #1
SEPTEMBER 21, 2018

The Drainage District Trustees of Boone and Story Counties met in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building to consider a written request (attached) to clean out approximately 11,000 feet of open ditch in Joint Drainage District Boone #28-Story #1, Boone County controlling. Members present were Bill Zinnel, chair, and Stephen Duffy of Boone County and Rick Sanders, Marty Chitty, and Lauris Olson of Story County. Also present were Story County Engineer Darren Moon and Boone and Story County Drainage Clerks Kaitlynn Moran and Scott Wall.

Zinnel called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Sanders asked if someone could walk us through what was being requested.

Moran said she had an email from Boone County Engineer Scott Kruse who couldn't attend the meeting today. Kruse wrote that he has been at the tile outlet during high and low flows and there are times when the water is above the flow line of the tile outlet. Kruse doesn't know if this indicates a problem with reduced flow in the ditch but recommends that the trustees hire an engineer to evaluate the Boone #28-Story #1 ditch and determine if a cleanout is warranted. Kruse isn't sure if the requesters' expectations are in line with a repair of the ditch or an improvement over the design capacity.

Sanders asked if Moon had anything to add.

Moon said he'd spoken to Kruse and concurred with him that an engineering study would be necessary to determine whether a cleanout was warranted.

Sanders asked if, with the request covering 11,000', the cost would exceed the \$50,000 threshold beyond which the trustees would have to hire an engineer anyway and, is that dollar threshold the same for joint districts.

Moon said that length of cleanout could exceed \$50,000.


Wall said the \$50,000 threshold is the same for any drainage district.

Zinnel moved, seconded by Sanders, to hire Bolton & Menk to conduct an engineering survey of the Boone #28-Story #1 open ditch and provide a recommendation to the trustees for a course of action regarding the received request. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.

Moran said she can contact Kent Rode at Bolton & Menk and request the engineering survey.

Duffy moved, Chitty seconded, to adjourn. MCU on a roll call vote. Meeting adjourned at 3:05 p.m.


