

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING
DISTRICT GRANT #5
APRIL 9, 2019

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building to consider a request from Alliant Energy to run new gas and electric lines under the Drainage District Grant #5 main tile. Members present were Linda Murken, chair, Lauris Olson, and Rick Sanders. Also present were County Engineer Darren Moon and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Murken called the meeting to order at 9:45 a.m.

Wall said Alliant Energy wishes to place underground gas and electric lines along the north side of Lincoln Highway between Ames and Nevada. These lines will cross under the main tile for Drainage District Grant #5. There are plans currently proposed for Grant #5 that would replace the main tile with a larger tile or an open ditch. In either case the depth of the new facility will be below that of the existing tile and the trustees need to be assured that Alliant's new utilities will pass under Grant #5's new tile or ditch. The initial contact with the engineering firm used by Alliant was on January 3, 2019. Moon modified a permit form used by Secondary Roads and Alliant's engineer submitted the signed form and plans (attached) on March 1. Our drainage district engineer at Bolton & Menk reviewed the Alliant plans and returned them with comments. The plans were resubmitted on March 29 and approved by Bolton & Menk.

Moon added that the permit he'd prepared was necessary because the proposed utilities are being placed outside the road right-of-way on private property. He has no objection to the work proceeding.

Sanders moved, seconded by Olson, to approve the permit and plans submitted by Alliant Energy to install new gas and electric lines under the Grant #5 main tile as recommended by Bolton & Menk acting as Story County's Drainage District Engineering Firm. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Olson moved, seconded by Sanders, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:48 a.m.

STORY COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT CROSSING PERMIT

To the District Trustees, Story County, Iowa:

do hereby make application requesting permission to cross a drainage district tile located along
Lincoln Highway (E41) between Ames, IA and
Nevada, IA

We mutually, as installer/contractor and/or owner, (Both hereinafter referred to as the permittee), agree that the following stipulations shall govern under this permit.

1. The Permittee will file plans setting out the location of proposed work and that the description of the proposed installation will be included showing type, height, and spacing of the same:

2. The installation shall meet the requirements of county, state, and federal laws, the Iowa State Department of Health, and any other laws or regulations applicable.
3. The Permittee shall be fully responsible for any future adjustments of its installations within the established drainage district right-of-way caused by district construction or maintenance operations.

4. The drainage district assumes no responsibility for damages to the Permittee's property occasioned by any construction or maintenance operations on said district.

5. The Permittee shall be responsible for any damage resulting to said district because of the construction operation, or maintenance of said installation, and shall reimburse the district for any expenditure the district may have to make on said district because of said permittee's installation having been constructed, operated, and maintained thereon.

6. The Permittee shall indemnify and hold harmless Story County and the drainage district from any and all causes of action, suits at law or in equity, or losses, damages, claims, or demands, and from any and all liability and expense of whatsoever nature for, on account of or due to the acts or omissions of said Permittee's officers, members, agents, representatives, contractors, employees or assigns arising out of or in connection with its (or their) use or occupancy of the district under this permit.

7. Noncompliance with any of the terms of permit, or agreement, may be considered cause for revocation of the permit.
