

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING  
MULTIPLE JOINT DISTRICTS  
MAY 29, 2019

The Boone and Story County Drainage District Trustees met in a telephone conference call in Conference Room A in the Administration Building in Nevada to consider levies against 3 joint drainage districts (see attached) and an engineering study of a fourth joint district, all controlled by Boone County. Members present were Stephen Duffy, chair, Bill Zinnel, and Chad Behn of Boone County and Linda Murken, Rick Sanders, and Lauris Olson of Story County. Also present were Boone County Engineer Scott Kruse, Auditor Philippe Meier, and Drainage Clerk Kaitlynn Moran and Story County Engineer Darren Moon and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Duffy called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m. and read the names and recommended levies of the three districts from the attached sheet.

Zinnel moved, seconded by Sanders, to accept the drainage clerks' recommendation for levies against the 3 drainage districts, said levies to be dated August 2019 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2019. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Duffy said a fourth joint district, Boone #93B-Story #4, has enough issues that Kruse would like Bolton & Menk, Inc. to prepare an engineering report.

Kruse said there have been problems in the past with tree roots infiltrating the district trial where it runs along Lincoln Way across the north edge of King's Terrace Mobile Home Park. King's Terrace has new owners who are willing to remove the offending trees. Steve Kaltenhauser, who farms the land south of King's Terrace has proposed rerouting the tile to the south side of the mobile home park and across his fields. Kruse doesn't have the time to devote to investigating this issue plus he believes that rerouting the tile qualifies as an improvement, which would require an engineer's report. The area has high potential for development and, if the tile is to be moved, it should be done before any development takes place.

Murken asked if the engineer's report is just to look at routing the tile around the mobile home park.

Kruse said there are two options to reroute but he would like the entire district examined as well.

Moon said this district had an engineer's report and reclassification performed about 10 years ago so a new report may not need to be as extensive.

Murken moved, seconded by Behn, to contract with Bolton & Menk, Inc to perform an analysis of Boone #93B-Story #4. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Sanders moved, seconded by Behn, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.

## **Joint Drainage Teleconference**

### **Boone County Board of Supervisors and Story County Board of Supervisors**

**Meeting as Trustees of Joint Drainage Districts - Boone 28/ Story 1, Boone 69/ Story 2, Boone 93B/ Story 4 and Boone 140/ Story 7**

**May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

Present: Steve Duffy, Chad Behn, Bill Zinnel; Boone County Board of Supervisors, Lauris Olson, Linda Murken, Rick Sanders; Story County Supervisors, Katie Moran; Boone County Drainage Clerk, Scott Wall; Story County Drainage Clerk, Scott Kruse; Boone County Engineer, Darren Moon; Story County Engineer, Phil Meier; Boone County Auditor

Duffy called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

Zinnel moved, Sanders seconded motion to approve Joint Drainage Levy Percentages as follows:  
Boone #28/ Story #1, a levy of 30% will raise \$11,932.42 leaving a balance of \$3,636.65,  
Boone #69/ Story 2, a levy of 405% will raise 5,060.88 leaving a balance of \$3,006.74,  
Boone #140/ Story #7, a levy of 20% will raise \$4,345.36 leaving a balance of \$3,052.46. MCU.

The Joint Boards had a discussion on Joint Drainage District Boone 93B/ Story 4. It was explained that this has been jetted near the existing trailer park. Kruse has spoken with the new owners of the trailer park and they would be willing to do some tree removal but Kruse doesn't think that would be enough. He believes that it should be re-routed around the park to try and alleviate future issues. Kruse thinks that this should be studied. Kaltenhauser would really like something to be done, his idea would be to go East to Y Avenue to go around the park. If this is re-routed Kaltenhauser may have to have an easement. Murken clarifies whether the study would be of the entire district or just of this area. Kruse states his opinion on two options for a re-route of this area to be studied.

Murken moved, Behn seconded motion to appoint Kent Rode with Bolton & Menk to study Joint Drainage District 93B/ Story 4 to find cost of re-route. MCU.

Sanders moved, Behn seconded motion to adjourn meeting. MCU.
