

The Board of Supervisors met on November 13, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers for the First-Tier Canvass of the City/School Election held on November 5, 2019. Present were Lisa Heddens, Linda Murken and Lauris Olson, with Chairperson Murken presiding.

Lucy Martin, Auditor, thanked her staff, election officials, and the departments of Facilities Management and Information Technology. She stated this was the first election to use the newly-purchased e-poll pads in all of the County's precincts; the new poll pads are very well-received by poll workers and voters. Eighteen (18) provisional ballots were cast in the election: ten (10) were accepted, and eight (8) rejected. Of the rejected provisional ballots, three did not meet the identification requirement, four were voted out of precinct, and one had an absentee ballot counted. Martin reported the return rate of 58% for absentee ballots was exceptionally low for this type of election; over 300 absentee ballots not returned from voters in Ames Ward 4. Due to no candidate receiving a majority of votes in Ames Ward 4, a run-off election will be held on December 3, 2019. Hours and polling places will be the same as for the 11/5/19 election. Absentee balloting will begin on Monday, November 18th. Martin reported the second-tier canvass will be held on November 19 to certify the results of jurisdictions in multiple counties.

Olson moved, Heddens seconded the approval of Resolution #20-39. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.

Heddens moved, Olson seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the election to the appropriate jurisdiction. Roll call vote. (MCU)

Olson moved, Heddens seconded to adjourn at 3:03 p.m. (MCU)

COMBINED CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on November 5, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers have canvassed the vote of said elections in accordance with §50.24 of the *Code of Iowa*, now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Story County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION, held November 5, 2019, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Seven thousand eight hundred twenty-eight (7,828) people voted at the polls on election day.

Six hundred seventy-two (672) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

Ten (10) provisional ballots were accepted for counting.

A total of eight thousand five hundred ten (8,510) people voted.

All races are for a term of four (4) years unless otherwise noted.
