Story County Extends Closure of County Facilities Through May 1, 2020

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

NEVADA, IOWA – In order to continue to protect the health and safety of Story County employees and the public, Story County is extending the closure of County facilities to the general public through May 1, 2020. This extension aligns with Governor Reynolds' proclamation extending statewide closures and prohibiting mass gatherings of 10 or more people. The closure date may be modified as needed.

This closure applies to all County buildings and facilities excluding the Justice Center in Nevada. Complete building closures include:

- Administration Building, 900 6th Street, Nevada
- Animal Control and Shelter, 975 W Lincoln Highway, Nevada
- Conservation Center, 56461 180th Street, Ames
- Engineer and Secondary Roads, Main Office at 837 N Avenue, Nevada (closure applies to all sheds throughout Story County)
- Human Services Center, 126 South Kellogg, Ames (DHS is seeing the public by appointment only)

All County services will remain operational and available to the public either online or via phone or email. Offices and Departments are making every effort to ensure minimal disruption to public services during this time.
