



Draw a line to connect the adaptation to an animal. An adaptation could be used for more than one animal, and an animal could have more than one adaptation.

1. Webbed feet for swimming.
2. Camouflage to hide from predators.
3. Warning colors to keep predators away.
4. Has opposable thumbs.
5. Only mammal that can fly.
6. Changes colors with the season for camouflage.
7. Babies have spots to blend in to camouflage while mom looks for food.
8. Has a tail to help it balance while climbing.
9. Has gills to breathe underwater.
10. Has a flat tail to smack the water for warning.
11. Has waterproof feathers to keep it dry.
12. Has a special defense where it sprays its predators with a smelly spray.
