



Mudpuppy

- Live in large rivers and streams, but can't handle habitat disturbance.
- Lay up to 100 eggs. 5 years to mature.
- Eats anything it can catch.
- Amphibian that is sensitive to pollution.
- Nocturnal
- Live under rocks and logs



Piping Plover

- Only nest on sandflats next to wetlands.
- Migrate to the Gulf coast in winter.
- Dull, camouflage feathers
- Lay 3-4 eggs per year.
- Feed along undeveloped water edges
- Are found in three different geographic regions.



Indiana Bat

- Spends the summer in dead or dying trees.
- Eats insects
- Migrates to caves to over-winter.
- Hibernates in groups of 100,000 + in caves.
- Has one young per year.
- Susceptible to invasive fungus that causes white-nose syndrome.



American Mink

- Has been introduced into Europe and South America.
- Feeds on rodents, fish, frogs, birds, & crayfish.
- Harvested for its soft fur.
- 1 litter of 4-12 kits. 10 months to mature.
- Dependent on aquatic habitats for food.
- Found throughout most of the U.S.
