

Precinct Ames 1-4

ONLY for the ballots mailed on October 5, voters in Ames 1-4 were sent the Ames 4-1 ballot. All affected voters were sent a letter on October 7 detailing their options.

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT BALLOT I RECEIVED (Ames 1-4 voters only)?

Check the label on the upper left-hand corner of your return affidavit envelope. Below the bar code and above your name and address is the precinct and ballot style information
