SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

A local sales and services tax for school infrastructure projects shall be imposed in the County of Story at the rate of one percent. The tax will begin on July 1, 2003. The tax will be in effect for a period of ten years until June 30, 2013.

The money received from the tax shall be spent for school infrastructure as defined by Iowa Code Section 422E.1. "School infrastructure" is defined by law to include purchasing, building, furnishing, reconstructing, repairing, improving or remodeling of a schoolhouse or schoolhouses and additions thereto, gymnasium, stadium, field house, or school bus garage, and procuring a site or sites therefor or purchasing land to add to a site already owned, or procuring and improving a site for an athletic field, or improving a site already owned for an athletic field, the payment or retirement of outstanding bonds previously issued for school infrastructure purposes or the payment or retirement of bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 422E.4, or for any one or more of such purposes.
