

JOINT DRAINAGE MINUTES
MULTIPLE BOONE-STORY DISTRICTS
MAY 27, 2020

The Boone and Story County Drainage District Trustees met in a telephone conference call in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building to consider levies against four joint drainage districts. Members present were Stephen Duffy, chair, Chad Behn, and Bill Zinnel of Boone County and Linda Murken, chair, Lisa Heddens, and Lauris Olson of Story County. Also present were Boone County Auditor Phil Meier and Drainage Clerk Kaitlynn Moran, Story County Drainage Clerk Scott Wall, and members of the public Erich Kretzinger and Jim Uthe.

Duffy called the meeting to order at 9:45 a.m. and listed the joint districts and the proposed levies (see attached levy sheets).


Moran spoke about Boone #93B-Story #4, Boone County controlling. The levy is based on a current shortfall in the district's fund plus the amount of a construction bid recently approved for a repair project in the district.

Wall spoke about the other three districts which Story County controls. Story County Integrated Roadside Vegetation Management (IRVM) has procured a quote for tree and brush removal along the open ditch in Boone #80-Story #3 and follow-up chemical treatments to prevent regrowth. In addition to the \$22,500 estimate, IRVM requested additional money for removal of beaver dams which have been a recurrent problem in open drainage ditches. Boone #143-Story #8 is also slated for ongoing treatment to control growth in the open ditch and to remove beaver dams. The Boone #201-Story #10 fund has been depleted by ongoing maintenance and repairs by county tile crews.

Murken moved, seconded by Behn, to approve the levies against the four joint districts as recommended by the Boone and Story County drainage clerks, said levies to be dated May 27, 2020 and to be due and payable on or before September 30, 2020. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Murken moved, seconded by Zinnel, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:51 a.m.
