

**The Board of Supervisors met on 3/12/24, at 9:00 a.m. in the Public Meeting Room at the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers for the Colo-NESCO Community School District (CSD) Special Election, held on 3/5/24. Present were Linda Murken, and Latifah Faisal, with Murken presiding. Lisa Heddens absent. (all audio of meetings available at [storycountyiowa.gov](http://storycountyiowa.gov); any resolution is effective upon signature and can be inspected M-F, 8-4:30, at 900 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Nevada, Iowa)**

**Lucy Martin, Auditor and Commissioner of Elections, reported the special election was for a Revenue Purpose Statement and three vote centers were used. She thanked staff for all their hard work. Because of the small size of the election, Martin was able to visit all voting locations and speak with election workers. The measure needed a simple majority to pass and had almost 86% 'Yes' votes. Martin stated no provisional ballots were cast in the election. Deputy Auditor Kevin Norris stated with no provisional ballots, and no military or Safe at Home ballots, the numbers from election night did not change.**

WHEREAS, a SPECIAL ELECTION was held for the Colo-NESCO Community School District as prescribed by law on March 5, 2024, and


