FY26 Budget Information

Pyle highlighted one adjustment made to the expenditures following the budget review at the February meeting.

Line #23 for radio subscriber fees. The Board voted to increase the proposed budget amount to \$122,200 to cover 30% of subscriber fees for Story County public safety agencies.

No modifications to revenue.

The budget estimate was published showing FY26 total expenditures \$482,165. Revenue to be raised by surcharge \$405,000 and other revenue receipts \$35,500.

Fitzgerald opened the hearing and asked if anyone wished to speak in opposition or in favor of the proposed budget. None.

No written comments received.

Hearing closed. No discussion or closing comments.

Huff made a motion to accept option A. Approve and adopt the FY26 budget as presented. Second by Grove. A roll call vote for members participating virtually produced all “aye”. Motion carried unanimously.
