

The Board of Supervisors met on 9/16/25 at 10:00 a.m. in the Story County Administration Building. Lisa Heddens, Linda Murken, and Latifah Faisal via zoom, with Heddens presiding. (all audio of meetings available at storycountyiowa.gov); any resolution is effective upon signature and can be inspected during business hours, Monday-Friday, 8-4:30, at 900 6th Street, Nevada, Iowa)

ADOPTION OF AGENDA: Murken moved, Faisal seconded adopting the agenda as listed. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.

CITY OF AMES AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) ANNUAL REPORT: Keith Abraham, Director of Parks and Recreations, City of Ames, reported on the Fitch Family Indoor Aquatic Center which has an expected opening date of March 2026. Abraham thanked the Board for its support. Non-Ames Story County residents will pay the same rate as Ames residents for the first ten years. He provided slides and pictures of floor plans, amenities, and construction progress. Discussion took place. Lucy Martin, Auditor, asked about assessing the building for elections purposes. Abraham invited Martin to a walk-through.

RESOLUTION #26-20, TO DESIGNATE LEVEL "C" ROADWAY: Darren Moon, Engineer, reported the County currently has no Level "C" roads. Both Level "C" and Level "B" roads have lower levels of maintenance. Designating a road as Level "C" adds gates to its access points. The stretch of road, partially located in Section 35 of Collins Township, is shared with Jasper County. Jasper County will install the south gate and Story County the north gate. Jasper County has already approved designating its portion of roadway as Level "C". Appropriate signage will be installed. The landowners requested the designation, will assist in road maintenance, and approve of the change. Discussion took place. Moon stated a No Trespassing sign will be posted. Murken moved, Faisal seconded the approving Resolution #26-20, to Designate Level "C" Roadway. Roll call vote. (MCU)

PURCHASING TWO TANDEM TRUCKS FOR \$316,676.70 EACH, FY27 BUDGET: Darren Moon, Engineer, reported the plan is to purchase two tandem trucks in FY27. Due to the current lengthy waiting period for trucks, Moon is requesting the County order the trucks now and approve the purchase. One truck will be funded from Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) and the other from the Engineer's local budget. Discussion took place. Moon stated the old trucks will be auctioned. Faisal moved, Murken seconded approving Purchasing Two (2) Tandem Trucks for \$316,676.70 each, FY27 Budget. Roll call vote. (MCU)

Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center (CIJDC) Settlement Agreement

WHEREAS, Story County Auditor is a stakeholder in the Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center (hereinafter CIJDC); and

WHEREAS, the CIJDC is the Respondent in Hardin County Case No. CVCV102247, whereby Hardin County calls into question the validity of prior 28E agreements; and

WHEREAS, the outcome of that litigation is uncertain, and Story County has an interest in the outcome of that litigation; and

WHEREAS, the CIJDC Commission has voted 22-5 to approve the attached compromise settlement agreement resolving the litigation; and

WHEREAS, the compromise settlement agreement is a compromise between Hardin County and the CIJDC that acknowledges the membership of counties joining the CIJDC through 2012 and also allows the remaining counties to maintain certain benefits that the litigation does not otherwise guarantee, while also allowing the counties joining through 2012 to adopt a new 28E agreement and even vote to allow the remaining counties to regain full membership in the CIJDC; and


WHEREAS, the Parties will file with the Court a consent decree memorializing the full terms and conditions of the Parties' compromise settlement agreement following approval of the compromise settlement by a majority of the member counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Story County Board of Supervisors to hereby approve and adopt the attached compromise agreement, and authorize the CIJDC to execute and present to the court a consent decree consistent with the attached compromise settlement.


RESOLUTION TO ABATE PROPERTY TAXES ON PARCELS OWNED BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION



THIS PACKAGE CONTAINS DOCUMENTATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NEW NATIONAL OPIOIDS SECONDARY MANUFACTURERS SETTLEMENTS. YOU MUST TAKE ACTION IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE.

Deadline: October 8, 2025

A new proposed national opioids settlement ("*Secondary Manufacturers Settlements*") has been reached with eight opioids manufacturers: Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus ("*Settling Defendants*"). This *Combined Participation Package* is a follow-up communication to the *Notice of National Opioids Settlement* recently received electronically by your subdivision.

You are receiving this *Combined Participation Package* because Iowa is participating in the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements*.

If a state is not eligible to or does not participate in the settlement with a particular manufacturer, the subdivisions in that state are not eligible to participate in that manufacturer's settlement.

This electronic envelope contains:

- A *Combined Participation Form* for the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements* that your subdivision is eligible to join, including a release of any claims.

The *Combined Participation Form* must be executed, without alteration, and submitted on or before October 8, 2025, in order for your subdivision to be considered for initial participation calculations and payment eligibility under the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlement*.

Based upon *Combined Participation Forms* received on or before October 8, 2025, the subdivision participation rate will be used to determine whether participation is sufficient for each settlement to move forward and whether a state earns its maximum potential payment under each settlement. If a settlement moves forward, your release will become effective. If a settlement does not move forward, that release will not become effective.

Any subdivision that does not participate cannot directly share in the settlement funds, even if the subdivision's state is settling and other participating subdivisions are sharing in settlement funds. Any subdivision that does not participate may also

reduce the amount of money for programs to remediate the opioid crisis in its state. Please note, a subdivision will not necessarily directly receive settlement funds by participating; decisions on how settlement funds will be allocated within a state are subject to intrastate agreements or state statutes.

You are encouraged to discuss the terms and benefits of the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements* with your counsel, your Attorney General's Office, and other contacts within your state. Many states are implementing and allocating funds for this new settlement the same as they did for the prior opioids settlements but states may choose to treat this settlement differently.

Information and documents regarding the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements*, implementation in your state, and how funds will be allocated within your state can be found on the national settlement website at <https://nationalopioidsettlement.com/>. This website will be supplemented as additional documents are created.

This *Participation Packet* is different than the participation packet you recently received from Rubris concerning a settlement with Purdue Pharma, L.P, and the Sackler Family. The *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements* discussed in this *Participation Packet* are different than the settlement with Purdue and the Sacklers, and you may participate in the *Secondary Manufacturers Settlements* regardless of whether you join the Purdue and Sackler settlement.

How to return signed forms:

There are three methods for returning the executed *Combined Participation Form* and any supporting documentation to the Implementation Administrator:

- (1) *Electronic Signature via DocuSign*: Executing the *Combined Participation Form* electronically through DocuSign will return the signed form to the Implementation Administrator and associate your form with your subdivision's records. Electronic signature is the most efficient method for returning the *Combined Participation Form*, allowing for more timely participation and the potential to meet higher settlement payment thresholds, and is therefore strongly encouraged.
- (2) *Manual Signature returned via DocuSign*: DocuSign allows forms to be downloaded, signed manually, then uploaded to DocuSign and returned automatically to the Implementation Administrator. Please be sure to complete all fields. As with electronic signature, returning a manually signed *Combined Participation Form* via DocuSign will associate your signed forms with your subdivision's records.
- (3) *Manual Signature returned via electronic mail*: If your subdivision is unable to return an executed *Combined Participation Form* using DocuSign, the signed *Combined Participation Form* may be returned via electronic mail to opioidsparticipation@rubris.com. Please include the name, state, and

reference ID of your subdivision in the body of the email and use the subject line Combined Settlement Participation Form – [Subdivision Name, Subdivision State] – [Reference ID].

12. The Governmental Entity understands and acknowledges that each of the Secondary Manufacturers' Settlements is an independent agreement with its own terms and conditions. Nothing herein is intended to modify in any way the terms of any of the Secondary Manufacturers' Settlements, to which Governmental Entity hereby agrees, aside from the exceptions in paragraph 13 below. 





RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE LEVEL "C" ROADWAY
Story County Resolution
No. 26-20

WHEREAS, Story County desires to classify a certain stretch of roadway on the area service system to provide for a minimal level of maintenance and access by means of a gate or barrier; and

WHEREAS, the County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service "C" roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57 (2025-) see attached reference Document 1 of 1; and

WHEREAS, Story County has received the attached request from the landowners, for a portion of 340th St. and 730th Ave. located on the south and east lines of Section 35, Township 82 North, Range 21 West of the Fifth P.M., Story County, Iowa, described as follows: **On 730th Ave.; beginning at the south right-of-way line of 330th St.; thence Southerly approximately 1.0 miles to 340th St.; thence westerly approximately 0.20 miles to the east right-of-way line of Jasper County Road W 110th St. N.** to become designated as Level "C" with gates installed.

1. **Blading.** Blading or dragging will not be performed on a regular basis.
2. **Snow and Ice Removal.** Snow and Ice removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Sanding and salting will not be performed on a regular basis.
3. **Bridges.** Bridges on Area Service "C" Roads may not be maintained to carry legal loads but will be posted as appropriate to advise of any load limitations.
4. **Weed, Brush, and Trees.** Mowing or spraying weeds, cutting brush and tree removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Adequate sight distances will not be maintained as on a regular road.
5. **Structures.** Bridges and Culverts may not be maintained on a regular basis to carry legal loads. Upon failure or loss, the replacement structures will be for traffic thereon.
6. **Road Surfacing.** There will be no surfacing materials applied to Area "C" Service roads.
7. **Shoulders.** Shoulders will not be maintained.
8. **Crown.** A crown will not be maintained.
9. **Repairs.** There will be no repairs on a regular basis.
10. **Uniform Width.** Uniform width for the traveled portion of the road will not be maintained.
11. **Inspections.** Regular inspections will not be conducted.

12. **Gate.** The gate shall be purchased and installed by the County and maintained by the County.

WHEREAS, the only persons who will have access rights to the road shall be:

- (1) The owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land.
- (2) The agent or employee of the owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land.
- (3) Any peace officers.
- (4) Any magistrate.
- (5) Any public employee whose duty it is to supervise the use or perform maintenance of the road.
- (6) Any agent or employee of any utility located upon the road.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF STORY COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the road described as an Area Service "C" road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.

309.57 Area service classification.

1. The county board of supervisors, after consultation with the county engineer, and for purposes of specifying levels of maintenance effort and access, may classify the area service system into three classifications termed area service "A", area service "B", and area service "C".

a. Area service "A" classification roads shall be maintained in conformance with applicable statutes.

b. Area service "B" classification roads may have a lesser level of maintenance as specified by the county board of supervisors, after consultation with the county engineer.

c. Area service "C" classification roads may have restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance as specified by the county board of supervisors after consultation with the county engineer.

(1) Area service "C" classification roads shall adequately warn the public that access is limited.

(2) Roads may only be classified as area service "C" by ordinance or resolution. The ordinance or resolution shall specify the level of maintenance effort and the persons who will have access rights to the road. The county shall only allow access to the road to the owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land, or the agent or employee of the owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession, or to any peace officer, magistrate, or public employee whose duty it is to supervise the use or perform maintenance of the road. Access to the road shall be restricted by means of a gate or other barrier.

(3) An area service "C" classification shall apply to the entire portion of a road between the road's access points. The county board of supervisors shall not classify only part of a road between the road's access points, or only a bridge on the road, as area service "C". This subparagraph does not apply to a road that terminates in a dead end. For purposes of this subparagraph, "access point" includes but is not limited to a driveway as defined in section 306.19.

(4) Notwithstanding section 716.7, subsection 2, paragraph "b", subparagraph (2), entering or remaining upon an area service "C" classification road without justification after being notified or requested to abstain from entering or to remove or vacate the road by any person lawfully allowed access shall be a trespass as defined in section 716.7.

(5) A road with an area service "C" classification shall retain the classification until such time as a petition for reclassification is submitted to the board of supervisors. The petition shall be signed by one or more adjoining landowners. The board of supervisors shall approve or deny the request for reclassification within sixty days of receipt of the petition.

2. a. Roads within area service "B" and "C" classifications shall have appropriate signs, conforming to the manual of uniform traffic-control devices adopted by the department, installed and maintained by the county at all access points to roads on this system from other public roads, to adequately warn the public they are entering a section of road which has a lesser level of maintenance effort than other public roads.

b. The county and officers, agents, and employees of the county are not liable for injury to any person or for damage to any vehicle or equipment, or contents of any vehicle or equipment, which occurs proximately as a result of the maintenance of a road which is classified as area service "B" or "C" if the road has been maintained to the level required for roads classified as area service "B" or "C".


