

The Board of Supervisors met on 11/12/25, at 3:00 p.m. in the Public Meeting Room at the Story County Administration Building as the Board of Canvassers for the First Tier Canvass of the City-School Election held on 11/4/25. Present were Linda Murken and Latifah Faisal, with Chairperson Murken presiding. Lisa Heddens absent.

Auditor Lucy Martin thanked staff, election technicians, temporary workers, the League of Women Voters members that assisted with satellite voting stations, and the poll workers. She stated the first-tier canvass is for cities and schools locate wholly within Story County. Entities in multiple counties will be canvassed on November 18 at 9 a.m. Turnout for Story County will be certified today. Martin reported twelve (12) provisional ballots were cast and two (2) were accepted for counting. Martin noted that this is Deputy Auditor Kevin Norris's final election with Story County and Deputy Auditor Victoria Skalinski's first election as deputy. She provided comparison data with previous City-School Elections. Martin stated the three public measures being certified today were all well above the required threshold for passage. She reported the post-election audit will be held on 11/14/25 at 9 a.m. in Conference Room West. Martin reported on the legislative change that now requires any newly-elected official to attend mandatory Open Meetings, Open Records training. Kevin Norris, Deputy Auditor, stated his thanks for the assistance and patience from the Board. He stated it has been a pleasure to serve this Auditor, the Board, and the citizens of Story County. He reiterated his thanks. Faisal moved, Murken seconded approving Resolution #26-32. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote. Faisal moved, Murken seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the election to the appropriate jurisdiction. Roll call vote. (MCU)

CERTIFICATION (CANVASS) OF STORY COUNTY ELECTION RESULTS
CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on November 4, 2025, and
WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and *ex-officio* Board of Canvassers has canvassed the vote of said elections in accordance with §50.24 of the *Code of Iowa*, now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and *ex-officio* Board of Canvassers of Story County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION, held November 4, 2025, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Nine thousand and fifty-nine (9,059) people voted at the polls on election day.

One thousand, two hundred and thirty-two (1,232) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

Two (2) provisional ballots were accepted for counting (subset of absentee ballots).

A total of ten thousand, two hundred and ninety-one (10,291) people voted.

All races are for a term of four (4) years unless otherwise noted.


