

DRAINAGE MINUTES
DISTRICT GRANT #5
JUNE 8, 2021

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building to appoint Drainage District Commissioners for the reclassification of Drainage District Grant #5. Members present were Lisa Heddens, chair, Latifah Faisal, and Linda Murken. Also present were County Outreach and Special Projects Manager Leanne Harter and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall and Jakob Hansu attending via Zoom.

Heddens called the meeting to order at 9:45 a.m. and said the meeting was open to public access due to room capacity restrictions being lifted and was available via Zoom as well.

Murken moved, seconded by Faisal, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Wall said Code of Iowa Section 468.38 states that the trustees shall appoint three commissioners to assess benefits and classify the lands in a drainage district. One shall be a competent Civil Engineer and the other two shall be resident freeholders of the county that do not reside in or have an interest in the drainage district involved. Story County has not formally appointed the commissioners in recent drainage projects but we should have and will from this point forward.

Faisal moved, seconded by Murken, to appoint Civil Engineer Kent Rode and Resident Freeholders David Anderson and Mark Tjelmeland as Drainage District Commissioners for the reclassification of Drainage District Grant #5. MCU.

Murken moved, seconded by Faisal, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:47 a.m.
