

The Board of Supervisors met on 11/15/22 at 3:00 p.m. in the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the November 8, 2022 General Election. Members present: Latifah Faisal, and Lisa Heddens, with Faisal presiding. Linda Murken absent. (all audio of meetings available at [storycountyiowa.gov](http://storycountyiowa.gov)).

Lucy Martin, Auditor, reported the Board will draw lots to determine the winner in two tied races, pursuant to *Code of Iowa* §50.44. Lots were drawn for Howard Township Trustee and BJ Schaben was declared the winner. Lots were drawn for New Albany Township Clerk and William Tucker was declared the winner. Martin asked for a short break to prepare canvass documents now that winners had been determined. Break began at 3:07 p.m., and the meeting resumed at 3:12 p.m. Martin reported on a one-time legislative change for hospital trustee terms. Martin thanked her Deputy of Elections Kevin Norris, her staff, the precinct election workers, temporary staff and technicians, and the Absentee Board. She thanked the Board and its employees for assistance, County Assessor Wayne Schwickerath and his staff for the use of a conference room for in-person absentee voting, Information Technology, Iowa State University, the League of Women Voters, local law enforcement, and all polling locations. She made special mention of the assistance provided by Facilities Management. Martin reported forty-eight (48) provisional ballots were cast in the election; the Absentee and Special Voters Precinct Board accepted thirty-one (31) provisional ballots for counting. Martin stated this is the last election using current election equipment. New equipment will be used in 2023 elections.

Heddens moved, Faisal seconded the approval of Resolution #23-37 certifying the results of the election. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.

Heddens moved, Faisal seconded to declare the canvass complete and to certify the results of the election to the proper jurisdiction (on file in the Auditor's Office). Roll call vote. (MCU)

Heddens moved, Faisal seconded to adjourn at 3:23 p.m. (MCU)

CERTIFICATION (CANVASS) OF ELECTION RESULTS  
NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the GENERAL ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on November 8, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and *ex officio* Board of Canvassers have canvassed the vote of said elections in accordance with §50.24 of the *Code of Iowa*, now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and *ex officio* Board of Canvassers of Story County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the GENERAL ELECTION, held November 8, 2022, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Twenty-six thousand six hundred and fifty-nine (26,659) people voted at the polls on election day.  
Ten thousand five hundred and eighteen (10,518) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.  
Thirty-one (31) provisional ballots were accepted for counting (subset of absentee count).  
A total of thirty-seven thousand one hundred and seventy-seven (37,177) people voted.


All terms are for four (4) years unless otherwise noted.



***§50.44 TIE VOTE.***

*If more than the requisite number of persons, including presidential electors, are found to have an equal and the highest number of votes, the election of one of them shall be determined by lot. The name of each of such candidates shall be written on separate pieces of paper, as nearly uniform in size and material as possible, and placed in a receptacle so that the names cannot be seen. In the presence of the board of canvassers, one of them shall publicly draw one of such names, and such person shall be declared elected. The result of such drawing shall be entered upon the abstract of votes and duly recorded, and a certificate of election issued to such person, as provided in this chapter.*
