PUBLIC HEARINGS: Discussion and Consideration of CUP22-000012 City of Nevada Tree Debris Site

Marcus Amman presented on the CUP22-000012 City of Nevada Tree Debris Site, staff's recommendation, as well as the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation.

Andrew Friend asked if the objective is to remove the debris out of the floodway.

Ryan Hutton, the applicant representing the City of Nevada, responded their current storage is where Nevada's new wastewater facility is being built so they are looking to move locations due to the floodplain. Hutton also commented on their priority to protect any natural areas from becoming a debris site. He also noted the concern for burning and it would be required for them to work with the DNR if that does ever become a prospect.

Matthew Neubauer asked if the debris site is temporary until the wastewater facility construction is completed.

Hutton responded they are unsure what the final construction looks like, and what would be most feasible to protect the area.

Amman spoke of the City initially being unaware acquiring a CUP was required.

Friend asked for clarification if this had been a previous CUP.

Amman and Hutton responded that isn't the case.

Friend asked about the size of the site and if it's large enough to accommodate major events that may produce a large amount of debris.

Hutton responded that yes, they believe this site's capacity would be enough in this case and noted they have other locations for these kind of events.

Neubauer asked if quarter mile radius notification was made and if the staff received any public comment.

Amman noted the commented he'd presented earlier was the only comment/

Neubauer opened Public Comment.

Schoeneman explained the next steps to approve or add/remove any conditions to the Findings of Fact to move forward.
