

**Story County E911 Service Board  
Public Budget Hearing  
March 14, 2011**

The E911 Service Board met on 3/14/2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Squad Room at the Story County Justice Center for the Public Hearing on the FY12 Budget.

Vice Chair Cychosz welcomed everyone. Board Members and those in attendance introduced themselves.

Hambly provided a brief overview of the FY12 Budget and reported no written opposition had been received for the proposed budget.

Cychosz opened the public hearing and asked if anyone wished to speak on the proposed budget. Hearing none, Cychosz closed the public hearing.

DeYoung moved; Tupper seconded to approve the 2012 Budget as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Cychosz briefed the members on the status of House File 611 and Senate File 448. Both bills were introduced to increase the 9-1-1 surcharge. Cychosz encouraged all board members to pay attention to the legislative actions.

Cychosz also stated the E911 Funding Grants were included in the budget however, the tower fees are escalating and the surcharge is decreasing. In the near future, the board will have to reduce costs significantly to pay for the core equipment needed to operate 9-1-1.

DeYoung moved; Stewart seconded to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
