

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING
JOINT DISTRICT HARDIN #35-STORY #1
APRIL 30, 2014

The Drainage District Trustees of Hardin and Story Counties met in the Board Conference Room of the Story County Administration Building in a telephone conference call to consider a levy for deficiency against Joint Drainage District Hardin #35-Story #1, Hardin County controlling. Members present were Rick Sanders and Paul Toot of Story County and Lance Granzow, chair, Brian Lauterbach, and Ronn Rickels of Hardin County. Also present were Hardin County Treasurer Machel Eichmeier, Auditor Renee' McClellan, Auditor's Clerk Tina Schlemme, Drainage Clerk Jane Geerdes, and Story County Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Granzow called the meeting to order at 10:50 a.m.

It is proposed that Hardin #35-Story #1 be levied at 23.95% of its original assessed value of \$32,964.78. This would cover an outstanding debt of \$2,852.66 and leave the district with a balance of \$5,042.41 going forward which the drainage clerks of both counties believe is an appropriate amount.

There being no discussion Sanders moved, seconded by Lauterbach, to levy Hardin \$35-Story #1 at 23.95% as recommended, said levy to be dated July1, 2014 with payments due on or before September 30, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business Granzow adjourned the meeting at 10:55 a.m.
