13. GENERAL UPDATES

Director Cox reported the following;

- Ames Town and Country Kiwanis recently completed the memorial pergola at McFarland Park.
- Emily Herring, Story County Conservation naturalist, has decided not to return from maternity leave. The recruitment for her replacement will close August 10. To date, over 50 applications have been received. Pease recommended an exit interview.
- Still no word on the formatting of the land at the Iowa State Research Park. Negotiations are continuing, but the DOT support for this project won't happen if the SCCB is no longer involved. The DOT money will go to land acquisition instead of mitigation.
- Received a follow up letter from Central Iowa Water regarding the Hickory Grove sewer project. Overall cost estimates have gone up. The lowest bid so far is \$236,000 which is higher than the original estimate of \$230,000. The current bid includes rehabbing the current system which the original consultant advised against. The mobile home court near the park could join the sewer project in the future, and the SCCB would get a rebate. Lots of questions still to be answered.
- Things are going very well with the water quality initiative. Director Cox toured with the water quality advisor on August 10. Will have an introductory meeting for Indian Creek watershed coming up.
- Currently working on a staff get together. Tentatively scheduled for August 25. Time and location TBD.

14. BOARD REPORTS

- Franz reported that she worked in a booth at the National Night Out with John Pohlman. Very diverse gathering. She offered kudos to Carol Williams for setting up a very nice booth.
- Meyers reported that he attended the most recent meeting of the Outdoor Alliance. They are currently working on developing a fundraising event.
- Tedesco reported that the City of Huxley is examining ways to fund their portion of the Heart of Iowa Trail. He asked how the Story County Conservation Board may be able to help, especially if there is a shortage of funds. Director Cox has also talked with officials from Huxley to see if we could help.
- Clinton reported that work continues on the "flex" issue for county employees. There are still a few things to iron out. A counter proposal has been submitted. He thanked Tedesco and Cox for participating in the strategic planning process.
