

The Board of Supervisors met November 5, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. in the Public Meeting Room at the Story County Administration building as the Board of Canvassers for the Ames City Runoff Election, held on November 3, 2015. Rick Sanders, Paul Toot, and Wayne E. Clinton present with Chairperson Sanders presiding.

Sanders read the results of the election.

Lucy Martin, Auditor, announced there were twelve (12) provisional ballot cast in Ames precincts; eight were accepted, and four were rejected. Reasons for rejecting the provisional ballots: three voted out of precinct, and one did not provide the required additional documentation. All provisional voters receive a letter stating the outcome of their ballots.

Clinton moved, Toot seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the election to the City of Ames. Martin stated the Ames canvass is held today because of the runoff provisions adopted by the city. There will not be a runoff election in Ames. The canvass for all other cities in Story County is next Tuesday canvass at 2:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Toot moved, Clinton seconded to adjourn at 2:05 p.m. (MCU)
