

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING
JOINT DISTRICTS POLK-STORY #2 & #4
JANUARY 12, 2016

The Drainage District Trustees of Polk and Story Counties met in a telephone conference call in Conference Room B in the Story County Administration Building in Nevada, IA to consider levies for deficiency against Joint Drainage Districts Polk-Story #2, Story County controlling, and Polk-Story #4, Polk County controlling. Members present were Paul Toot, chair, Rick Sanders, and Wayne Clinton of Story County and Tom Hockensmith, chair, Robert Brownell, Angela Connelly, Steve VanOort, and John Mauro of Polk County. Also present were Polk County Planning and Development Manager Bret VandeLune, Story County Engineer Darren Moon, and Story County Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Toot called the meeting to order at 9:15a.m. and read item #1 from the agenda (see attached) stating that Polk-Story #2 funds are deficient and that Story County is recommending a 13% levy.

Brownell moved, seconded by Clinton, to approve a levy of 13% against Polk-Story #2, said levy to be dated January 12, 2016 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2016. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

VandeLune read item #2 stating that Polk-Story #4 funds are deficient and that Polk County is recommending a 20% levy.

Mauro moved, seconded by VanOort, to approve a levy of 20% against Polk-Story #4, said levy to be dated January 12, 2016 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2016. MCU.

Clinton moved, seconded by Connelly, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
