

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MEETING
MULTIPLE DISTRICTS
MAY 29, 2019

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in Conference Room A in the Administration Building in Nevada to consider levies against 6 drainage districts (see attached). Members present were Linda Murken, chair, Rick Sanders, and Lauris Olson. Also present were County Engineer Darren Moon and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Murken called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.


Wall spoke about the proposed levies. Five are being proposed because completed repairs have depleted district funds below zero. These are Drainage Districts Franklin #39, Colo-New Albany #9 & 48, Nevada #88, Collins #100, and Union #112. Story County levies drainage districts such that there is a contingency fund after claims are paid sufficient to cover small, future repairs and avoid levying the district in the next year. Depending on the Original Assessed Value of the district the carryover balance in each district will be between \$2,000 and \$5,000 with \$5,000 being the most we would want to have in any district that does not have work ongoing.

Richland #20 Sub #3 is the exception. Bolton & Menk, Inc. has been retained under the District Watchmen program to replace a crushed district tile under the Union Pacific Railroad just south of Fernald. Current debt is \$9,249.50 for engineering services and the repair is estimated to cost \$49,000. Wall is recommending a \$20,000 levy to pay off the existing debt and cover future engineering costs. If the project proceeds as planned, it will be completed in July and we will levy the district again in 2020 to pay for the repair work. Bids are to be solicited in June but until then, we can't know what the final cost of this repair will be.

Sanders moved, seconded by Olson, to accept the drainage clerk's recommendation for levies against the 6 drainage districts, said levies to be dated August 2019 with assessments due and payable on or before September 30, 2019. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Sanders moved, seconded by Olson, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
