

The Board of Supervisors met on March 10, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in the Board Room at the Story County Administration as the Board of Canvassers for the Special School Elections (multiple districts), First-Tier held on 3/3/2020. Present were Linda Murken, Lisa Heddens, and Lauris Olson, with Chairperson Murken presiding. Lucy Martin, Auditor, reported on the five school elections; all public measures passed. Voter turnout for the general obligation bond elections for Colo-NESCO and Collins-Maxwell were 37% and 29% respectively. The absentee ballot return rate was 92%. Four (4) provisional ballot were cast; all four were rejected. Martin also stated the Auditor's Office is losing Chris Andringa; he accepted a new job and the office will miss him greatly. Heddens moved, Olson seconded the approval of Resolution #20-69. Motion carried unanimously (MCU) on a roll call vote.

Olson moved, Heddens seconded to declare the canvass complete and certify the results of the election to the appropriate jurisdiction. Roll call vote. (MCU)

Heddens moved, Olson seconded to adjourn at 9:04 a.m. (MCU)

WHEREAS, a SPECIAL ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on March 3, 2020, and



BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Story County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION, held March 3, 2020, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Two thousand two hundred twenty-three (2,223) people voted at the polls on election day.
One hundred fifty-seven (157) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.
Zero (0) provisional ballots were accepted for counting.
A total of two thousand three hundred eighty (2,380) people voted.


