Antidegradation Alternatives Analysis for the City of Story City, Iowa

Notice Date: January 6, 2020

Notice is hereby given that the City of Story City, Iowa has completed a draft antidegradation alternatives analysis for discharge of treated wastewater to South Skunk River. The action being considered is construction of an extended aeration activated sludge wastewater treatment facility to replace the City's existing sequencing batch reactor activated sludge treatment system. The South Skunk River is protected for Class A1, B(WW-1) HH.

Impaired Waterbody: The following stream segments in the discharge route are on the 2016 impaired waters list:

- South Skunk River for bacteria (indicator bacteria - E. coli), a fish kill, and low fish and invertebrate IBIs.
- Skunk River for bacteria (indicator bacteria - E. coli).
- Mississippi River for metals (aluminum).

Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed treatment alternative must do so in writing within 30 days of the date shown at the top of this notice. Comments may be submitted to the City Clerk by hand delivery, mail or email: scaclerk@iowatelecom.net
