MAPS 2021 Proposed Budget Discussion

Schwickerath reviewed the proposed budget for 2020-2021 with the members of the MAPS Committee. The only changes in the budget compared to last year were increases in salary (and corresponding benefits) and the Beacon Real Estate Website hosting fees. Discussion followed.

McConville made a motion to approve the budget as presented. Second by Wall. All voting members voted "Aye" and the budget was approved. Schwickerath will now include the MAPS budget with the County Assessor budget and present it at the conference board meeting early next year.

County Assessor – Working on new construction, re-val a few cities. Trying to get a lot done before weather gets really bad

City Assessor – New construction, budgeting, taking advantage of good weather

GIS Coordinator – Working on Ballard school bus route maps, county trail layer cleanup, submitted roads and address points to the state (data meets accuracy standards to receive state

grant), need to refresh some GIS layers and data (server and database side), will work on capturing more GPS data next spring, agland calculations for assessors

Auditor – Working on splits and combines – a few to catch up on

County P&D – Working on putting C2C maps on AGOL, Gabe the intern is creating a Python script for the LESA process, also planning to work with Story City to get their zoning layer on Beacon, updating natural resources layer

County Engineering – updating snow plow maps and the bridge layer

Emergency Management – Nothing to report

Health – Have had difficulty using the Ames pipes web service, Cory would like Boeck and McConville to look into that (McConville wanted everyone to know that they also have a utility viewer web app), also there is septic information on Beacon now

911 – Will start working on 911 budget soon, radio project is moving along well – initial tests have been successful, will start transitioning users to new system soon

Ames Engineering – New aerals have been captured, working on winter related GIS maps, Dominic has been working with Operations Dashboards more, working on future land use plans, also looking at purchasing a drone in the future
