Auditor – Splits, combines, some new subdivisions (will not have data in them until July/August)

County P&D – Had a de-annexation for Story City, some conditional use permits

County Engineering – Worked with Boeck to scan some documents, some roads are closed

County Recorder – They are now full staff, worked with Boeck to scan in some large format documents

Emergency Management – Working with Iowa Homeland Security – damage assessment app, will work with Boeck to set up necessary ArcGIS Online logins, Boeck will complete Tier II changes and update maps
