

Story County Conservation modified Naturally Sensational Field Trip (Grades 3-4th)

This is a video of the “Naturally Sensational” Field Trip created by Story County Conservation that is designed to help you explore your five senses and compare them to animal’s adaptations that help wildlife survive. To participate in this video you will need to gather a few items:

First: Down load and if you are able to Print this “Naturally Sensational Booklet” if you are unable to print the booklet, you can still follow along using it online. Or you can stop by the Story County Conservation Center and call 515-232-2516 to pick up a booklet of your own.

To perform all of the experiments, you will need the following supplies:

1. Cup filled with vinegar
2. A hard candy (such as a mint, jolly rancher, or starbursts)
3. A straight stick (pencil length) or dowel, or pencil
4. A tape measure
5. A piece of chalk
6. A bag
7. 6 Random toys that can fit in the palm of your hand, and a wrapped food item (granola bar, chocolate bar, etc.)
8. A flat piece of wood you can stand on, or a storage tub lid, or large piece of cardboard
9. A hammer, paint brush/ruler, and stick
