SUBJECT: Flood Insurance Rate Map Zone Information for the unincorporated areas of Story County, Iowa.

As a public service, Story County will provide you with the following information upon request:

- ◆ Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) of the County.
- ◆ Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM zone and the base flood elevation or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- ◆ We have a handout on the flood insurance purchase requirement that can help people who need a mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- ◆ We have copies of completed FEMA Elevation Certificates for buildings built in the floodplain since 1991.

If you would like to make an inquiry, please tell us the street address and, if available, Parcel number. We are open 8:00am to 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday. Call us at (515) 382-7247 or drop by the Story County administration building. There is no charge for this service.

- ◆ We have a Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) on staff that can assist with questions about flooding and drainage issues.
