SUBJECT: Notice of Contaminated Area – Former Kerr McGee, 436 Lincoln Way, Nevada
Tank Registration No. 197910660 LUST No. 9LTQ97

To Whom it May Concern,

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is required to notify individuals who may be potentially affected by a site that is contaminated with petroleum from a leaking underground storage tank. On November 10, 2015 the DNR classified the above listed site as "high risk".

Soil and groundwater samples were collected to investigate the level of petroleum contamination present. Laboratory results of one or more of the samples exceeded acceptable levels. The following conditions exist:

- Fumes from the contamination may accumulate in nearby enclosed spaces (i.e., basements, sanitary sewers or other underground enclosed spaces)
- The petroleum contamination has the potential to penetrate the walls or gaskets of certain kinds of water lines. Sampling results indicate the water lines are not currently impacted.

After a review of all available information, the DNR believes these conditions will not pose an immediate threat to your health or safety. A plan to monitor the problems noted above has been developed. You will be notified if conditions significantly change. Corrective actions to alleviate the high risk conditions will be initiated in the future.


