

Dear Vietnam Veterans:

In the event that one or more of you or someone you know is affected by bladder cancer, please call me. Understand that even though you may not be eligible for entry into the VA medical system through normal channels, if you had service in Vietnam or some bases in Thailand, you are considered exposed to agent orange or Jet Fuel. This can and probably will qualify you for entry into the VA medical system. Otherwise, they look at your household income and assets.

Bladder Cancer Due to Agent Orange and/or Jet Fuel (JP-4) is granted now by VA.
