

## Rent and Utility Assistance

**Community Services** (515) 663-2930, 126 South Kellogg Ave. Suite 001 (Story County Human Services Building). Monday–Friday, 8 AM–4:30 PM. Helps with current rent or utility bills when eligibility criteria are met. Does not assist students.

**Emergency Residence Project (ERP)** (515) 232-8075, 225 South Kellogg Ave. Helps with past due rent, deposits, and utilities when funds are available. No appointment needed, applications are accepted Mondays and Thursdays, 9:00 AM–3:30 PM.

**Good Neighbor Emergency Assistance** (515) 296-1449, 613 Clark Ave. No appointment needed. Hours: Mondays and Thursdays, 10:00 AM–4:00 PM to apply for rent and/or utility assistance; gas and food vouchers.

**Christ Community Church** (515) 232-2765, 5501 George Washington Carver Ave. Wednesday 1-3 PM. Must live in Ames or Gilbert. Denials not required. Can assist with deposit, rent, and utilities.

**Salvation Army** (515) 233-3567, 703 East Lincoln Way. Monday–Friday, 9 AM–12 PM & 12:30–3:30 PM. Must call first to determine eligibility. Can assist with deposit, rent, mortgage, and utilities.

**St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church** (515) 292-3810, 2210 Lincoln Way. Appointments only. Call Monday–Friday, 9:30 AM–12:00 PM to schedule an appointment. Denials from MICA & Community Services required.

**Mid-Iowa Community Action (MICA)** (515) 956-3333 or 1-877-289-4668, 230 SE 16th St. May be able to help with utilities in danger of disconnection, depending on available funds. Need disconnection notice and copy of most recent bill. Must be within income guidelines and provide proof of income for last 90 days. May be able to help with furnace repairs and replacements.

**November 1 – April 15: Non-Emergency Energy Assistance. Call for an appointment.**

**St. Patrick's Catholic Church (Good Samaritan)** (515) 382-2974, 1110 11th Street, Nevada. Appointments only. **For Eastern Story County communities only (E of I-35; not Ames).**

**Commission of Veterans Affairs** (515) 956-2626, 126 South Kellogg Ave. Suite 001. Provides assistance to eligible Story County Veterans who were discharged under Honorable Conditions and/or their family members.

**Telephone Assistance Program (Lifeline)** Provides a credit on your phone bill (land line or cell phone) each month. To be eligible, applicants must participate in one of the following programs: Medicaid, Free and Reduced Lunches, Food Stamps, Federal Housing Programs, FIP, SSI, or LIHEAP.
